Guest Speakers

At the April 16th USAC council meeting, USAC members were joined by Jill Musser, Senior Director of Employee Benefits, and Candy Yekel, Associate Vice President for Research, to discuss employee data. In addition, the council watched the <u>Diversity</u>, <u>Equity</u>, <u>Inclusion</u>, <u>and Belonging</u> (<u>DEIB</u>) <u>Update</u> with President Neeli Bendapudi and Special Adviser for Institutional Equity Jennifer Hamer.

Committee Updates

- The Awards Committee reviewed all submissions for the USAC Staff Awards and selected the recipients. The committee is coordinating the awards ceremony, to be held May 2023.
- The Communications Committee oversaw announcements in Penn State Today regarding USAC membership applications and the <u>USAC Presents seminar on Edible Gardening Tips</u>. Committee members continue to update USAC's social media channels and <u>website</u>.
- The Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Committee is continuing to review the University's newly launched <u>DEIB dashboard</u> to discuss findings and implications for university staff and USAC. The committee intends to use information gathered from the dashboard, Jennifer Hamer's recently released report, and the <u>2020 Community Survey</u> to determine upcoming USAC event topics.
- The Logistics and Events Committee is helping coordinate two upcoming travel meetings in May and
 June, as well as the USAC Awards ceremony in May. The committee also planned the third installment
 of the USAC Presents series, which has been rescheduled to Friday, May 12th at 1:00 pm and will focus
 on home gardening with a speaker from the Penn State Master Gardeners program. Interested
 participants can register through LRN.
- The Membership and Elections Committee has reviewed all applications for the 2023-24 and is finalizing the interview process. Applicants will be notified of their status by the end of May. The committee also completed the election of new USAC Leadership for 2023-24.
- The Outreach Committee is planning two Community Engagement meetings, one on May 18th to the Harrisburg campus and one on June 15th to the New Kensington campus.
- The History Committee is compiling historical information regarding USAC and preparing to contribute records to the University Archives. Because available USAC historical information is limited, current or former USAC members are encouraged to share documents that may be relevant to creating a historical picture of the council and its activities.
