Guest Speakers

At the February 16th USAC council meeting, USAC members were joined by Iris Richardson, the Director of Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) for the <u>University Policy and Public Safety</u> (UPPS). Iris described her efforts to incorporate DEI into all aspects of UPPS, including community relations, leading initiatives, and training.

Committee Updates

- The Awards Committee is currently accepting <u>nominations</u> for the annual USAC Staff Awards. The
 committee is also planning the USAC awards ceremony for May 2023 and sent an invite to all USAC
 members.
- The Communications Committee published press releases on <u>USAC membership applications</u>, the <u>upcoming USAC Presents seminar</u>, and <u>USAC Staff Awards nominations</u>. Committee members have been updating USAC's social media channels and the <u>USAC website</u>.
- The Inclusion, Equity, and Diversity Committee, with leadership from Chair-elect Rachel Galloway, hosted two Listening Sessions in early February to collect feedback regarding staff morale. The committee is organizing and analyzing the data; the results will be shared with university leadership later this spring. The committee also discussed and presented a vote to change the name to the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) committee in alignment with other PSU initiatives. The motion passed at the council level.
- The Logistics and Events Committee hosted the second <u>USAC Presents seminar</u> on February 23rd in collaboration with the Faculty Senate. The topic was employee orientation to EAP and work/life. In addition, the committee continues to coordinate logistics for USAC's upcoming travel meetings and the USAC Summit in March. Lastly, the committee is documenting the processes for hosting training events to help future committee members.
- The Membership and Elections Committee is accepting USAC membership applications for the 2023-24 academic year. The committee updated the application and prepared a press release. The committee is also organizing the election of USAC Leadership for 2023-24.
- The Outreach Committee is finalizing details for the USAC Summit, which will be held March 30th, 2023 at the Technology Support Building. The committee is also planning two travel meetings: one in May to the Harrisburg campus and one in June to the New Kensington campus.
- The History Committee is compiling historical information regarding USAC. They met with University
 Archivist, Ben Goldman to discuss what materials the archives wants to collect from USAC. Because
 available USAC historical information is limited, if any former USAC members have documents saved
 that may be relevant to creating a historical picture of the council and its activities, please email
