## **Guest Speakers**

At the November 17<sup>th</sup> USAC council meeting, USAC members were joined by Michael Wade Smith, Penn State's Senior Vice President & Chief of Staff to the President. Michael joined the University in March, and this was USAC's first time to meet and talk with Michael. He briefed the council on his role at Penn State, his background and past experience, and answered a variety of question asked by USAC members. Questions included topics such as staff perspectives, how his past experiences could apply at Penn State, and Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB).

## **Committee Updates**

- The Awards Committee has begun scheduling and planning for the awards ceremony next spring. The committee updated the nomination form and is working on an announcement for the USAC Awards.
- The Communications Committee completed a <u>press release</u> highlighting the annual report, members, and bylaws. Committee members have been updating the information on USAC's social media channels and the <u>USAC website</u>, where a new <u>Positive Paws</u> page was added. In addition, at the latest meeting a discussion was held regarding new ways for USAC to engage the Penn State community.
- The Inclusion, Equity, and Diversity Committee is discussing initiatives for the upcoming year, including a Listening Session in the next few months.
- The Logistics and Events Committee is looking into speakers for USAC's speaker series, "USAC
  Presents." The tentative topics will be on introducing employees to things they might not know about
  Penn State. This is expected to be a four-part spring 2023 series. Watch Penn State Today for
  announcements. In addition, the committee is continuing to help coordinate logistics for USAC's
  upcoming travel meetings and the USAC Summit in March.
- The Membership and Elections Committee discussed the onboarding process and potential changes to the interview process.
- The Outreach Committee has been busy planning several travel meetings for the upcoming year. Planning has also begun for the USAC Summit, which is slated for March 30, 2023 at the Technical Support Building.

#### **Actions and reminders**

- The winter break schedule for 2022 <u>was clarified</u> earlier this year according to an updated version of <u>HR34</u>. The days off include December 23, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and January 2, 2023.
