



NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES

REMEMBER, IT IS IMPORTANT TO TELL YOUR EMPLOYER ABOUT YOUR INJURY.

In accordance with the Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Act Section 306 (f.1)(1)(i), you must choose a physician or other Health Care Provider from the list below.

IN CASE OF WORK-RELATED INJURY OR DISEASE

If you suffer a work-related injury, the University will Pay for **reasonable** surgical and medical services, medicines, supplies, orthopedic appliances and prostheses, including training in their use.

In order to ensure that your medical treatment will be Paid for by the University, you **must** select from one of the physicians or health care providers listed below.

You must continue to visit one of these physicians or health care providers listed above, if you need treatment, for **90 days** from the date of your first visit.

After this 90-day period, if you still need medical treatment, you may choose to go to another physician or health care provider of your choice. **If this situation should arise, you must let the Office of Human Resources Workers' Compensation office know within 5 days of the first visit or your medical treatment may not be considered for payment.**

If one of the physicians or other health care providers listed above refers you to another physician or health care provider your employer or his insurer will pay the reasonable bills for these services.

If you are faced with an **immediate medical emergency**, you may secure initial assistance from the nearest hospital. You must then seek subsequent treatment from a physician or other health care provider listed above for at least the first 90 days from the date of your first treatment.
